Format: Virtual

### **EXCHANGES**

Format: Virtual and In-Person

## COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS LOUNGE

Format: Virtual and In-Person

The Community Connections Lounge convenes virtual and in-person participants in small group discussions during scheduled times each day of the event. Attendees informally discuss issues important to the profession in an engaging format without presentations.
