NCMA CODE OF ETHICS

The [NCMA Code of Ethics](#) applies to NCMA meetings and events participation. NCMA reserves the right to take any action deemed necessary and appropriate, including immediate removal from the meeting without warning or refund, in response to any incident of unacceptable behavior, and NCMA reserves the right to prohibit attendance at any future meeting, virtually or in person. This includes:

- Disruption of presentations during sessions, in the exhibit hall, or at other events organized by NCMA throughout the virtual meeting. All participants must comply with the instructions of the moderator and any NCMA virtual event staff.
- Presentations, postings, and messages should not contain promotional materials, political messages, special offers, job offers, product announcements, or solicitation for services.
