Requirements:

Assignment for 1 Graduate-Level Credit:

- A. Make a copy of your certificate attendance or a pic of your badge.
- B. Attend a minimum of 8 hours of conference sessions. This usually means 8 one-hour sessions or equivalent hours of longer workshops.
- C. Write a brief summary of each session/workshop attended. Summarize the session in 150-250 words. Cover the following topics:
 - What can I apply to my teaching?
 - What were the strengths?
 - What would have made this session/workshop more valuable to me?
 - Include the attached Session Attendance Log (attendees will be able to create and retrieve their transcript/session log and forward it along with other documents required to receive the credit). They will evaluate each session attended to create a transcript of attendance.

Cost: \$100 for one graduate credit (*check payable to Cambridge College – memo line: NSTA Conference Credit- SCI 608*)

Accreditation & Types of Credits/Units

Cambridge College is accredited by The New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC). The credit offered is graduate-level, meaning that it is post-baccalaureate. It is primarily utilized for professional growth or salary advancement. It is transferable to degree programs only on the approval of the institution being petitioned. Carnegie Graduate-Level Semester Credits are characterized by 12.5 hours of contact time per credit/unit, and are associated with a measure of knowledge assessment and/or skills implementation. The words Credits and Units are used interchangeably as geographical locations vary in terminology. **Grades will be awarded as Pass/Fail.**
